Pool Rules

1. Current pool tags are required to enter.
2. All members and their guests must register with the lifeguard upon entering the pool facility. Members will be held responsible for the action of their guests.
3. Children 10 years old and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult of 18 years or older at all times. Lifeguards are not responsible for supervision of underage children.
4. Wading Pool is for children up to 6 years old; children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult of 18 years or older at all times.
5. All swimmers **must** wear bathing suits. No cut-off jeans, shorts or tennis pants allowed. Only white shirts can be worn as protection from the sun in the water.
6. No diving in shallow end of pool (less than 6 feet)
7. No bicycles, skateboards, roller blades or scooters allowed in the pool area.
8. No pets, except seeing-eye dogs are allowed on the premises.
9. No dangerous items such as tennis balls, frisbees, etc. allowed in the pool area. Toys of soft materials are allowed at the lifeguard's discretion
10. No loud, abusive or vulgar language allowed.
11. No loud music allowed.
12. No electrical cords. Battery operated radios only at a low volume.
13. No alcoholic beverages and No smoking allowed.
14. No glass containers allowed.
15. No food, drinks or gum in the pool.
16. No loitering.
17. No trespassing.
18. No running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, dunking, splashing or horseplay in pool area.
19. Only Coast Guard approved life preserves are permitted and the supervising adult must be within arms reach of the child wearing the life preserver.
20. Management will not be held responsible for loss or damage of any personal property of any kind.
21. The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather, operational difficulties, overcrowding, and at the discretion of the manager. In case of lightning or thunder, Red Cross standards will be used.
22. The lifeguards on duty have full authority to enforce all rules pertaining to the safety of the pools.
23. Failure to follow the rules may result in immediate removal from the pool area and charges may be filed with the Harris County Sheriff Department.
